

WEATHER EMERGENCY

OBJECTIVE:

To ensure that the security supervisor is capable of monitoring poor weather conditions and informing plant officials of possible danger.

METHOD:

During inclement weather, the Main Gate Security Officer will monitor the weather band radio. When notified of eminent danger of a hurricane, severe windstorm or a tornado striking this area, the following actions will be accomplished:

1. Notify plant Shift Supervisor of weather conditions.
2. Run YELLOW ALERT.
3. Lower the gate barriers and leave them down until the danger no longer exists.
4. At night, or on weekends, ensure that the Shift Supervisor is aware of the conditions.

FIRE EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

OBJECTIVE:

To ensure that the security supervisor is capable of properly coordinating actions with the ERT in the event of a fire.

METHOD:

In the event you see or are notified of a fire within the plant, or on adjacent LOUISIANA GENERATING property, take the following actions:

1. Determine the location of the fire from the person who reported it, or by observation.
2. Call control room operator _____ to report the location of the fire. If you hear the ERT response alarm, do not call.
3. If the LOUISIANA GENERATING fire chief or assistant requests, call the New Roads Volunteer Fire Department. Tell them where the fire is and what gate to enter.
4. If the fire is severe, run YELLOW ALERT.
5. Raise the gate barrier and notify guards at other gates to do the same.
6. Remain at the guard post for further instructions.
7. As soon as things are under control, notify the following individual

Note: When the fire is under control, incident reports should be completed.

GENERAL PLANT EMERGENCY

OBJECTIVE:

To ensure that the security supervisor is capable of informing and organizing additional security assistance in the event of an actual plant emergency.

METHOD:

Although _____ has an outstanding safety record, the possibility of a serious life-threatening emergency exists. If this happens, the following procedure will be used, by security only, for the call out of additional security personnel.

- A. **YELLOW ALERT** – This security information will be used when the plant has an existing emergency such as a fire, chlorine leak, bomb threat, etc., that could lead into a life threatening situation. The Main Gate will call off duty security personnel and inform them that we are in a **YELLOW ALERT** condition. You will then prepare to come to work and remain on standby in case the condition worsens. Do not come to work but remain on standby.
- B. **RED ALERT** – This condition will exist when the plant emergency worsens or deteriorates into a life-threatening situation, such as an actual boiler explosion, a fire out of control, etc. The Main Gate will contact additional security personnel and advise them that we are now in a **RED ALERT** condition. Security personnel are to report to work immediately.

NOTE: On both **ALERT YELLOW** and **RED** condition, the Main Gate will not waste time discussing the extent of the emergency. Security personnel will not discuss the incident with anyone.

Many press agents will be in the area. Do not allow access or give out any information. This date will be released later by _____ Management.
